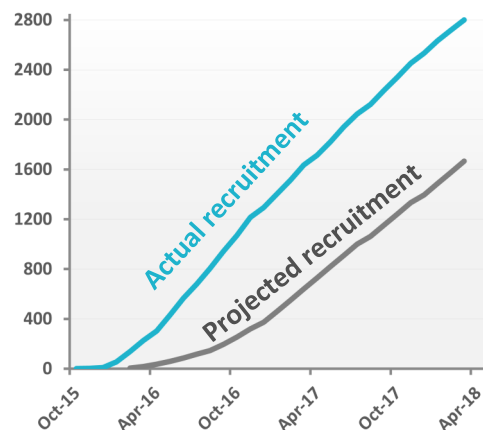


ERIC-PPCI has completed recruitment!

We are thrilled to announce that ERIC-PPCI completed recruitment of **2800 patients** on **28 March 2018**. This is an amazing achievement of which all in the ERIC-PPCI community should be proud. Our initial sample size was 2000 patients and our initial end date for recruitment was 31 July 2018. As such we completed recruitment 4 months early with 800 additional patients. Well done all!

The final patient was recruited by **Michelle Anderson at Leeds General Infirmary**. Congratulations Michelle and team! A special prize will be sent out to you this week.

Now that we have completed recruitment, the focus will shift to ensuring that the dataset is complete and that all events are reported and documented. The ERIC-PPCI CTU is here to support you during the follow-up period. Please let us know if we can be of any assistance.

Congratulations to all of you for having recruited an amazing 2800 patients into our ERIC-PPCI trial! This would not have been possible without your enthusiasm, dedication, and hard work. We would like to express our huge gratitude to everyone of you for all your time and effort. Completing recruitment of 2800 patients into the ERIC-PPCI study is a massive achievement for all of us, and we thank all of you from the bottom of our heart.

Together with the CONDI2 trial which has just completed recruitment of 2600 patients in Denmark, Spain, and Serbia, we will have an amazing 5400 patients in total! The results from the combined trials will be known in March 2019 when we have completed the one year follow-up for all patients. We therefore now need your continued help to kindly follow-up all recruited patients to the one year end-point. The results from our study are of huge importance and will provide a definitive answer as to whether remote ischaemic conditioning can reduce cardiac death and re-hospitalisation for heart failure at one year in STEMI patients, and therefore the findings from our trial have the potential to change clinical practice.

ERIC-PPCI device returns

We are starting to contact sites to coordinate the return of all the devices and unused cuffs. We will arrange for a courier to collect them from you to be brought to us. You will start to hear from our trial assistant Lucy Collier from next week.

Users can now edit data in the eCRF

To assist with ensuring that the data entered in ERIC-PPCI is as correct as possible, we have made it possible for users to edit the data they have entered without raising a query with the CTU. This will eliminate the need to contact the ERIC-PPCI CTU with simple data changes. To edit data, follow these steps.

1. Click "Edit" next to the relevant form (see red box on the image to upper left).
2. The data currently saved can now be edited.
3. Once all of the data edits have been made, enter a "Reason for Edit" at the bottom of the form (e.g. data entry error) and click "Save Form".
4. The data entered will appear on screen so that they can be double-checked. Enter your password at the bottom of this page to confirm that the data are correct and save the form.
